The American Legion Legacy Scholarship Fund (42-1553035) was set up to ensure that military service children who are suddenly in single parent homes or with a veteran parent with a VA disability rated at 50% or higher since September 11, 2001, are able to attend higher education institutions to complete their education. It is estimated that there are 10,000 children that fit this description. The goal is to raise 25 million dollars to ensure all service kids who qualify have the option of post secondary without having to worry about where the funds will come from. The need is only expected to continue to grow.
